It is advisable that the above fees are paid in advance of the convention, preferably by the 30th November 2017.

Accommodation Options

We have taken good care to ensure that the places of accommodation to be utilised by the brethren are, among others, convenient, clean, secure, easily accessible to public transport. It is, however, strongly advised that the brethren intending to attend the convention inform us (through booking tools to be shared with their Pastors) of their preferred places of aboard and other personal considerations that we should take into account in preparing to host the brethren. All effort shall be made to ensure that we satisfy such needs the best way we can.

1. Hillside Primary School

Accommodates more than 400 people. They provide shared facilities, duly separated to cater to the Sisters and Brothers. Rooms will be allocated in the order with which we receive confirmation from the respective brethren/churches.

Arrangements have also been made for *all* meals to be served at the convention place (Nambole Stadium).

For Brethren staying at Hillside Primary School, the cost of accommodation and feeding is catered to under the Registration Fees above.

Transport and Visa Application Information

Kindly take note of the following recommendations in your planning:

1. Travel:

For brethren traveling from outside Uganda coming by:

1.1 Road:

- 1.1.1 It is advisable that you let us know in advance of the dates and times you intend to travel/arrive in Kampala. Preferably, Brethren should arrange their transport in terms of Churches or groups.
- 1.1.2 It is also important that you confirm the mode of transport you will be using.
- 1.1.3 Brethren driving their cars into Uganda are required to have valid original driving permits and to take out insurance cover for their cars. This will be done at the port/border point of entry into the country.
- 1.1.4 Public transport (at a fee yet to be agreed - you shall be informed in due course) at the respective bus and mini bus taxi terminals shall be arranged to transport Brethren to their respective places of aboard. We shall have presence at such travel terminals to help Brethren traveling by public means.
- 1.1.5 Kindly take care of your personal belongings at all times during the course of travel.
- 1.1.6 Please keep in touch with the brethren whose numbers appear at the base of this

invitation letter for finer details on how best to manage your travel itinerary.

1.2 Air

- 1.2.1 It is advisable that you let us know the dates and times you intend to travel/arrive at Entebbe International Airport.
- 1.2.2 It is also important that you confirm the Airline you will be traveling with so that we can adequately plan for your transport to your place of aboard.
- 1.2.3 We shall have presence at the Airport to help Brethren traveling by air.
- 1.2.4 Kindly take care of your personal belongings at all times during the course of travel.
- 1.2.5 Please keep in touch with the brethren whose numbers appear at the base of this invitation letter for finer details on how best to manage your travel itinerary.

2. **Visa/Entry Requirements:**

All Brethren traveling are required to have the necessary travel documents in order to enter the country:

2.1 **Brethren who are citizens of East African Member States**

- 2.1.1 Such Brethren are not required to secure a visa to enter Uganda.
- 2.1.2 However, you must have a valid passport; or a temporary travel document (including 2 passport size photos, another form of identity card e.g., national ID, driving permit, etc) issued by your home country in order to enter the country.
- 2.1.3 Although it is not essential that such Brethren should have an official, personal Invitation Letter to prove purpose, duration and place of aboard while in the country, we would advise that you have these on your person in the event that the authorities require you to prove the above. Kindly fill in and return by email the convention registration form [here](#) so that we can prepare the Invitation Letter for you.

2.2 **Brethren who are not citizens of East African Member States:**

- 2.2.1 a valid passport;
- 2.2.2 fill a visa application form.
- 2.2.3 non-refundable visa application fee of US\$50.
although it is possible for Brethren traveling from Europe and America to secure a Ugandan visa at the point of entry, it is advisable that all Brethren (especially those traveling from within Africa/Non-East African Member States) to secure visas from the Ugandan Embassy of their respective home countries. **Please visit the link below for finer details in this regard <https://www.immigration.go.ug/content/visas-and-passes>**
- 2.2.4 For an official, personal Invitation Letter, kindly reach us on email kampalaconvention@gmail.com and we will get you all the details needed.
- 2.2.5 Evidence of exit travel itinerary (e.g., a return ticket for Brethren travelling by air).
- 2.3 In addition to the above, ALL Brethren (including those from East African Member States) are required to have the following additional documents so as to enter the country, i.e.:
 - 2.3.1 A yellow fever vaccination certificate.
 - 2.3.2 For Brethren traveling with children, you shall be required to provide/carry a copy of each child's birth certificate or document proving guardianship/custody of such child or written consent of such child's parents (for unaccompanied minors).
 - 2.3.3 Please ensure that you have the required documents issued/provided to you by the relevant authorities/entities well in advance of your travel. Please have all such documentation readily accessible on your person during travel.
